NV Open Studios Awards Are Announced

Yountville artist Steven Gordon's pastel work, "Returning Path," was chosen Best of Show by a panel of judges for the Napa Valley Open Studios Tour, in the second annual juried show under the auspices of the Arts Council of Napa Valley.

The same piece also won Gordon the People's Choice

Award II, a \$100 certificate for custom framing from North Light Gallery.

Gordon received a \$200 US Savings Bond from Napa National Bank. His work can be seen daily at "Steven Gordon Studio Gallery," Vintage 1870 in Yountville.

Honorable Mention went

to St. Helena resident Angela Tirrell for an untitled work inspired by an old stone floor.

Tirrell, who will travel next year to Nepal to create a mural at an orphanage as part of an effort to bring assistance to the country's poorest children, works in Napa at a studio located in

Tannery Row.

The People's Choice Award I, chosen by ballot at the Open Studio Tour gallery exhibition at Domaine Carneros, went to Catherine Anderson for her watercolor, "One Fine Day."

Anderson, whose studio is located at 7111 Dry Creek Road, received \$100 from the di Rosa Foundation.
